MISSION

The Leesburg Police Citizens Support Team, Incorporated is organized to aid, support, and in all lawful manner, assist the Police Department of the Town of Leesburg, Virginia, in the prevention of crime and the promotion of public safety.

BACKGROUND

The Leesburg Police Citizens Support Team, Inc. (LPCSTI) was established as an integral part of "community policing" in Leesburg, Virginia. "Community policing" involves bringing the police officers and the law-abiding citizens of Leesburg together to find permanent solutions to public safety and crime prevention problems. LPCSTI is a non-profit, volunteer organization of law-abiding citizens which works closely with the Leesburg Police Department to further those "community policing" goals.

Formed in April 1996, the Team's membership of civic-minded men and women have contributed countless hours of volunteer service to the Leesburg Police Department and the Town of Leesburg and have been recognized by Federal, State, and local authorities and civic groups. LPCSTI supports the Leesburg Police Department through a number of activities, including: child DNA kit distribution, traffic speed and flow monitoring, neighborhood patrolling, manning drug education and public safety displays, conducting safety seatbelt and street light surveys, assisting in community policing meetings, directing traffic, and helping with crowd control at accidents, emergency scenes and special events.

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Prospective LPCSTI members must be U.S. citizens and Virginia residents, 21 years of age or older, hold a valid Virginia operator's license and have a clean driving record, be able to pass a police background check, and be willing to volunteer a minimum of 6 hours' time each month.
